Alcoholism Counselors – The work involves assisting with the rehabilitation of alcoholism patients at the Erie County Medical Center Corporation by applying generally accepted methods and techniques of rehabilitation counseling. The incumbent implements established service plans, including structural activities, individual and group counseling and social network development. Work is performed under the direct supervision of higher-ranking counseling staff and other professional staff members. This is professional counseling work with limited responsibility for the supervision of lower level counseling and clerical staff.

Benefit Assistant – The work involves assisting in the administration of benefit programs for employees and retirees of the Erie County Medical Center Corporation. The incumbent assists in coordinating and communicating benefit plans, processes benefit applications, maintains accurate enrollment records and performs a variety of benefit-related calculations. Work is performed under the direct supervision of the Benefit Specialist.

Certified Nursing Assistants – The work involves performing routine and semi-skilled tasks in the overall care of the physically ill, physically disabled and mentally incapacitated residents and patients at the Long Term Care Facility of the Erie County Medical Center Corporation. The activities performed support the daily functions and operations of an assisted unit or area. Work is performed under the direct supervision of professional or non-professional nursing staff in accordance with the policies and regulations of local, state and federal authorities as well as accepted standards of practice.

Healthcare Information Reporting Specialist – The work involves performing the analysis, design and programming of electronic medical record applications for maintaining and extracting data at the Erie County Medical Center Corporation. The incumbent is responsible for developing and generating various data reports as required and training employees in various departments on utilizing the electronic applications. Work is performed under the general supervision of a higher level health information technology professional with oversight performed by an administrator in the areas for which work is assigned.

HIV/AIDS Peer Navigator – The work involves outreach and providing services to clients at risk for HIV infection and disseminating information to the general public for increasing an individual's ability to access and remain in the continuum of care and support services that promote early medical intervention. The incumbent will assist case management efforts in engaging clients who are resistant to or have poor adherence to medical care due to various psychosocial issues such as mental health, substance abuse, lack of HIV education and poor health literacy. The incumbent will perform a variety of duties along the HIV services continuum such as developing an outreach plan for locating infected persons, stabilization in primary and supportive care, and accompanying patients to clinical appointments and community support programs. Independent fieldwork may be required. Work is performed under the direct supervision of a Social Casework Manager or other higher-level supervisor.

Pharmacy Aides – The work involves performing routine semi-skilled tasks within the Pharmacy Department at the Erie County Medical Center Corporation. The incumbent assists in medication distribution in a hospital or retail pharmacy setting. Work is performed under the direct supervision of a Pharmacist or higher ranking pharmacy staff.

Respiratory Care Practitioners – The work involves administering a variety of respiratory care services to patients with pulmonary and cardiac diseases and other respiratory complications at the Erie County Medical Center Corporation. The incumbent sets up and operates equipment and administers respiratory therapy with the concurrence of a qualified physician. Work is performed under the direct supervision of a higher level professional and medical staff.

Senior Technical Assistant Information System – The work involves providing technical assistance and instruction in the capabilities, applications and information systems at the Erie County Medical Center. This is a customer service position which provides hands-on assistance to system users by resolving questions and problems related to information systems or hardware. Work is performed under the direct supervision of a higher level professional, technical and administrative staff.

Patient Access Services Representatives – The work involves performing hospital or professional billing functions, collecting and accounting for monies received, and details prevention analysis in the Hospital Billing Department for the Erie County Medical Center Corporation. The incumbent submits and follows up on all billing and claims for the facility and performs analysis to identify denials, appeals and corrective actions to maximize reimbursements. Work is performed under the direct supervision of a higher level administrative staff.

Certified Medical Office Assistants – The work involves performing clerical and patient oriented clinical tasks and direct patient care at the Erie County Medical Center Corporation. This is a paraprofessional position responsible for assisting with patient screening, registration and discharge, performing routine patient point of care screening and clinical functions. Work is performed under the direct supervision of a higher level technical or professional employee with leeway for the exercise of independent judgment.



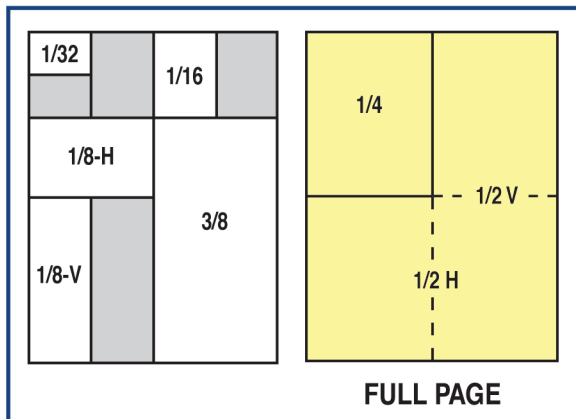
